

MAIDSTONE

Located 65km from London on the banks of the River Medway, the town of Maidstone, county-town of Kent in the United Kingdom, boasts a population of 138,959.

Easy to reach from Beauvais via the Channel Tunnel, this industrial and commercial hub also has a multitude of sports facilities and leisure centres, as well as historic sites, an unspoilt environment, and one of the world's most beautiful castles.

The name Maidstone probably means "the place (of stone) where maids meet". Maidstone and Beauvais became twin towns in 1961 and have built between them an indestructible bond of friendship.



For nearly 60 years, multiple exchanges have taken place in the context of sports, like table tennis, hiking and on the occasion of the Sports Festival, as well as school exchanges involving the Bossuet and Saint Esprit schools, not forgetting the cultural sector with exchanges between choirs, friendship clubs and so on.

TILLICOULTRY

The town of Crèvecœur-le-Grand has been twinned with the Scottish town of Tillicoultry since 2012. Tillicoultry is about sixty miles from Glasgow and Edinburgh in the county of Clackmannanshire. It is one of the so-called "Hillfoot" villages to be found at the foot of the picturesque Ochil Hills. It offers a warm welcome, an outlet shopping centre, and beautiful walks with great views and stunning scenery.

TAKE A PLUNGE INTO HISTORY













1 CATHEDRAL OF SAINT-PIERRE



The town of Beauvais is dominated by the prodigious dimensions of Saint-Pierre Cathedral with its 13th-century Gothic chancel, the tallest in history, towering 48 metres above the ground. Beauvais is unique, with not one but two cathedrals! The old cathedral, known as "Basse Œuvre", is a valuable testimony of the architecture of the year 1000.

2 ASTRONOMICAL CLOCK

Its staggering height of 12 metres and wealth of information on the seasons, tides, eclipses, etc. make the astronomical clock very impressive. Recently restored, this 19th-century masterpiece comes to life several times a day as its 68 automatons perform their perfectly synchronised display.

3 CHURCH OF SAINT-ETIENNE



WALK

Saint-Etienne Church, one of the oldest in Beauvais, is a remarkable demonstration of the transition between Romanesque and Gothic architecture. The stained-glass windows have been recognised as Renaissance masterpieces. They are the 16th-century works of the Le Prince dynasty, a local family of expert glass-makers.

The MUDO (Musée de l'Oise) is a museum occupying the prestigious palace of the bishop counts of Beauvais. The MUDO's rich collection of nearly 1,000 paintings includes some 19th-century works as well.

THE **QUADRILATÈRE**

The Quadrilatère centre proposes a programme of temporary exhibitions that create a special link between art and architecture, across history right up to some rather more modern experiments.

5 LA TOUR BOILEAU

Vestige of the medieval fortifications placed in advance of the rampart, the tower defended the city against the artillery guns likely to be positioned on the Saint-Jean hillside which borders the Thérain at 150 m. Take the time to stroll through its small bucolic garden and enjoy the lapping of the river.

6 CHÂTEAU DE **TROISSEREUX**



A picturesque Renaissance dwelling of brick and stone built in the 15th and 16th century. Guided tour with the château owners: alchemical tower and medieval timepiece. The château stands in beautiful leafy grounds designed by Bernard Palissy and featuring some very old trees and a bird sanctuary.

1 LEPER HOUSE OF SAINT-LAZARE



3 BRULE **GARDENS**



This park of Medieval inspiration occupies a former leper house dating from the 13th century. It is an invitation to switch off and contemplate. It comprises several spaces dedicated to different themes: the contemplative gardens of Mary and in the cloister, the medicinal herb garden, the kitchen garden, the grains garden, and the berry fruit garden and vineyard.

The painter took all his inspiration from the dahlias, water lilies and hydrangeas of this life-sized open-air colour palette. Your eyes are in for a feast as you wander between flower beds and lily ponds. To finish in style, take a little detour via the workshop where you'll be greeted by tubes of colour, canvasses, brushes and a whole gallery of paintings.

MOTHER-OF-PEARL AND MARQUETRY MUSEUM



Occupying a 19th-century factory, the museum safeguards and showcases the local crafts of button-making and marquetry. You'll discover how buttons are made from mother-of-pearl in an accurate reconstitution of a button-making workshop where a steam generator still operates.

ESCAPE INTO THE GREAT OUTDOORS







1 HIKING

The undulating landscape, the tranquil forests where you can pick mushrooms or daffodils, depending on the season, and a dedicated greenway for the whole family, invite you to escape as you follow the trails and footpaths of Beauvais and the surrounding region.

The Tourist Office proposes waymarked paths to discover the traditions of the villages, like the pottery studio in Savignies where creative craftspeople are still busy at work, the shimmering colours of the cereal plains in early summer, the shady heart of forests like Neuville-en-Hez, and bucolic riverbanks like that of the Liovette flowing through Guignecourt. Along the way, you'll come across such curiosities as an old tithe barn, some castle ruins and even a monumental wine press.
